One of our prayer requests is for God to send an Aquila & Priscilla Team. An Aquila & Priscilla Team is a family, couple, or individual who attends a church plant and uses the gifts and talents that the Lord has given them to build up the body of Christ in the church plant. This is not a paid position, but is an opportunity to serve the Lord in church planting as a lay person.

Each Aquila & Priscilla Team is a little different depending on the team's availability and situation. Some teams have moved away from home for several years to be near a church plant and help out. Other teams attend one that is already relatively close by or decide to drive a distance for their time of service.

The teams have been retired couples and fam-

ilies with young children. This would also be a great opportunity for a college student. The team can choose to serve for what ever length of time works for them, typically one to two years, but can be shorter or longer.

The team can teach children's classes, run youth group, reach out to the church plant's community, help with building maintenance, or use whatever other skills and gifts the team has. All teams will prioritize getting to know new visitors, inviting people to the church plant, and discipleship.
