Church Revitalization in Maple Glen, PA February 2023

Church Extension Ministries of the Bible Fellowship Church in partnership with Faith BFC of Harleysville, PA

Revitalization

In December 2021, the BFC denomination approached the elders at Faith BFC in Harleysville with the proposition to take under its wings a church in need of revitalization. The pastor of Maple Glen BFC, Lou Prontnicki, announced he was retiring at the end of June 2022 after 30+ years of faithful service and they needed a plan for moving forward. The elders at Faith BFC discussed the proposition and in January 2022 informed the congregation at Faith BFC of this proposal. Over several months, information was gathered, questions were asked, but most importantly, the face of the Lord was sought. In April 2022, the congregation of Faith BFC agreed to officially embark on the process of revitalization with Maple Glen BFC.

The two congregations merged and a pastoral search committee was formed with members from both worship locations. After many interviews and much prayer, the search committee presented me to the elder board as the pastoral candidate. Following a candidate weekend where much time was spent together, the members at Maple Glen unanimously approved me as their new pastor. Beginning October 2022, I began the work of shepherding the flock of Maple Glen BFC.

Relaunch

A launch team was formed and has worked on a new mission, vision, and core values for the church as well as a new name. Maple Glen BFC is now Welsh Road Church: Built on the Bible, Centered on Christ, Growing God's Family. Our main focus is church health. The work of revitalization follows the pattern of: remember, repent, recover. We must remember the past and God's faithfulness to His church, but we must not live in the past. We must recognize where we have failed and look to Jesus in humility. Then we must recover the church's first love: Jesus Christ in all His beauty.

We have also been updating the physical building and property. So far we have installed new locks, upgraded the IT infrastructure, purchased all-new sound equipment and new pew bibles, painted new lines on the parking lot, installed new security cameras around the property and building, created a new logo and signage, and a new website is in the works. There are many other projects coming down the pipeline such as: remodeling the nursery, building a bathroom on the main floor, updating the platform, and refreshing the sanctuary.
